

If you feel that you couldn't come to a service but would still like to know more about what the church is like, you can:




LINK TO LATVIA...

SOME HISTORY...

The Baptist Chapel in Clarence Street was built in 1836. It is one of the few Baptist chapels left in Cornwall. The church, the group of Baptist believers committed to each other, had begun meeting together for worship in 1802. They wanted to be a church who had the truth of the Bible as their foundation. They felt that the 1689 Baptist Confession of Faith helped to summarise what they believed the Bible taught. This remains to be the position of the church. The church has a rich history, and we hope, under God, a blessed future.

The front architectural design of the chapel is striking and gets attention from all over the world. Many visitors come to the Baptist church through the year but thankfully not just to look at the building. They visit for the services and to hear what the Bible has to say. You are welcome to come and do the same. We hope that once you come inside you will find not just a historic building, but a warm welcome from the people inside! Over the years, many people of all ages have come to explore the Christian message, its relevance to their lives, and have found peace with God at the Baptist Church. Why not explore it for yourself?
